### Catholic Customs

The second of the series of short articles by Fr Rowan on Catholic Customs is available this Sunday. ### Special Meeting

A Special Meeting of Enrolled Members is to be held, with the Archbishop's permission, **on Sunday 25th October**, following the Choral Mass of that Sunday. This meeting is in lieu of our usual AGM, which could not be held due to COVID-19 restrictions in June. The meeting will have a minimal agenda - Wardens' Report, Financial Report, Election of Officer Bearers, Other Business. There will be no Rector's Report, there being no Rector until Fr Rowan is formally commissioned and licensed in that capacity early next year. Parishioners who are not on the Parish Roll, or are uncertain about their status, are encouraged to complete an Enrolment Form available in the narthex. Nominations forms for Parish Council are also available in the narthex. Nomination forms must be in the hands of Fr Rowan 7 days prior to the meeting.

Most of you will have received, with my permission, a poster for the forthcoming concert by Olivia Sanders, our Mapstone Singers soprano, on Sunday 11 October here in the church at 2pm.
