## This Week's Readings ... 20<sup>th</sup> September

Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost

Anthem: Love divine all loves excelling – Willcocks

Exodus 16: 2 – 15    Philippians 1: 21 – 30    Matthew 20: 1 – 16

Psalm 105: 1 – 6, 37 – 45

*Refrain: Remember the marvels the Lord has done.*

- 1 O give thanks to the Lord and call upon his name;  
make known his deeds among the peoples.
- 2 Sing to him, sing praises, and tell of all his marvellous works.
- 3 Rejoice in the praise of his holy name;  
let the hearts of them rejoice who seek the Lord.
- 4 Seek the Lord and his strength; seek his face continually.
- 5 Remember the marvels he has done,  
his wonders and the judgements of his mouth,
- 6 O seed of Abraham his servant, O children of Jacob his chosen. [R]
- 37 Then he brought them out with silver and gold;  
there was not one among their tribes that stumbled.
- 38 Egypt was glad at their departing,  
for a dread of them had fallen upon them.
- 39 He spread out a cloud for a covering and a fire to light up the night.
- 40 They asked and he brought them quails;  
he satisfied them with the bread of heaven. [R]
- 41 He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out  
and ran in the dry places like a river.
- 42 For he remembered his holy word and Abraham, his servant.
- 43 So he brought forth his people with joy, his chosen ones with singing.
- 44 He gave them the lands of the nations  
and they took possession of the fruit of their toil,
- 45 That they might keep his statutes and faithfully observe his laws. Alleluia.

feed your Easter people with the bread of heaven,  
that we may hunger and thirst for righteousness  
until we reach our promised land; through Jesus Christ our Lord.*
