Catholic Customs

The first of the series of short articles by Fr Rowan on Catholic Customs that he mentioned in his Parish Directions statement is being reprinted again this Sunday in case some parishioners missed it. So this is the first of a monthly series on topics, large and small, not in any particular order but as dimensions of how to be a Catholic Christian suggest themselves to Fr Rowan.

Special Meeting

A Special Meeting of Enrolled Members is to be held, with the Archbishop's permission, on Sunday 25th October, following the Choral Mass of that Sunday. This meeting is in lieu of our usual AGM, which could not be held due to COVID-19 restrictions in June. The meeting will have a minimal agenda - Wardens' Report, Financial Report, Election of Officer Bearers, Other Business. There will be no Rector's Report, there being no Rector until Fr Rowan is formally commissioned and licensed in that capacity early next year. Parishioners who are not on the Parish Roll, or are uncertain about their status, are encouraged to complete an Enrolment Form available in the narthex. Nominations forms for Parish Council are also available in the narthex. Nomination forms must be in the hands of Fr Rowan 7 days prior to the meeting.
